Ms. Lacey:

Thank you for your past attention to this case. Recently, Mr. Goodwin sent you the irrefutable evidence of 32 perjuries, 25 by the prosecution's "*Number 1 expert witness, Dolores Cordell,*" and 7 perjuries by others. Mr. Goodwin requested that the 2nd District Appellate Court be advised by your office of this evidence before they make their final decision on this case, which is imminent.

As you know, you are obligated by your oath of office and authority to report false testimony to the court as soon as you become aware of it. Included in that law is the requirement, "*when you learn of information which casts doubt on the accuracy of the testimony of one of your experts*" you are to report that immediately as well. That authority is included in PEOPLE v SEATON 26 Cal. 4th 598,647, GIGLIO v U.S. (1972) 405 U.S. 150,154-155; U.S. v AGURS (1976) 427 U.S. 97, 103; NAPUE v ILLINOIS, (1959) 360 U.S 264, 269; in re JACKSON (1992) 3 Cal 4th 578, 597, PEOPLE v DICKEY (2005) 35 Cal. 4th 884, 909; PHILLIPS v OMO SKI (9th Cir. 2012) 673 F3b 1168,1118 and many, many others as authority on this is legion.

A copy of this linked document has been sent to Mr. Louis Karlin of the California Attorney General's office and Lt. Reinhardt Schuerger of the Los Angeles Sherriff's Department's Professional Standards Division. VOLUME 2, Exhibits R through Z will be sent at a later date. Of most interest to your office are the at-trial perjuries outlined in Exhibits B, C, P & Q. Also note, in Exhibit A, pages 7601 and 7609 which detail blatant contradiction by Detective Lillienfeld and, also in Exhibit A, pages 7605, 7607 and 7612-7617 which are annotated as to the relevant issues they illustrate.

An exhibit list is included, located after Exhibit Q. This brief contains many different documents, each page numbered separately so page number references in each document are specific to that document/exhibit and not the bates page numbering which I have added for your convenience in the upper right corner.
